## Alamo Federal Executive Board Emerging Leaders FEB (ELFEB) FY23

**BACKGROUND ELFEB:** In 2019, the Alamo Federal Executive Board (AFEB) established “Emerging Leaders FEB (ELFEB)” - a program targeting the GS 7-11 grade levels (and military/other pay plan equivalents) and recognizes the need for professional development at this level to help groom and fill parts of the skills gap as outlined in the President’s Management Agenda. The goal of ELFEB is to give aspiring leaders that deeper dive into self-awareness and targeted training as well exposure and **opportunities** to learn from key decision-makers in both the private and public sectors.

**QUALIFICATION and SELECTION:** Nominations are made by respective federal agency heads within the AFEB primary serviced area. ELFEB is limited to **40 participants** representing the broadest cross-section of employees possible.

The ELFEB Steering Committee selects class members based on a review of applications. If necessary, the committee will conduct personal interviews.
